

Congestive Heart Failure Visits by Week Missouri Residents, Federal Fiscal Year 2019 vs. 2020



Heart attack visits to Missouri hospitals during the COVID-19 pandemic declined 6.5%, or a difference of 839 visits, compared to the same time period in 2019. The data for congestive heart failure is even more alarming with a 14.1% decline in visits, or a difference of 10,001.

MISSOURI HAS THE 12TH HIGHEST DEATH RATE FROM CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE IN THE COUNTRY.
