



Founded in 1977, The Women's Safe House serves as a haven for women and children (ages 0-18) who are in immediate danger and fleeing domestic abuse. The organization offers a full range of programs and services for 400-500 women and children annually, including a Crisis Hotline, Residential Program, Children's Residential Program, AfterCare Program and Community Education. Individuals have access to 12 weeks of safe shelter, including meals, clothing and personal care items; group and individual educational sessions; children's programming; legal advocacy; financial literacy workshops; transportation assistance; job placement guidance; and support in finding new safe housing. Children are provided a nurturing environment where they can play or take part in structured activities. TWSH's services work to empower women to make informed choices about their future.

In 2018, the facility provided 14,239 nights of emergency shelter, answered 3,556 crisis hotline calls and benefited from 3,349 hours of support from 531 volunteers.
