

## Facility-Specific Reports for OP-32

The FSR contains the facility's risk-standardized results, patient-level data, and state and national results for the colonoscopy measure. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services encourages facilities to review their FSRs and accompanying User Guide thoroughly. ### **Accessing Your Facility-Specific Report**

**Facilities do not need to request FSRs: FSRs are available through the *QualityNet* Secure Portal.** Registered users should be able to access their accounts and FSRs by logging into the Portal and clicking *Secure File Transfer* from the top right corner of the screen. From here, users can view their mailbox and select *Inbox* to access their facility's FSRs during the October 2018 preview period. Facility staff currently assigned the designated roles ("File Exchange & Search" role and "View QNet Content" role) will have access to their FSRs in their *QualityNet* Secure File Transfer Inbox. Facilities can register for a *QualityNet* account and gain Secure Portal access by visiting the *QualityNet* website ([www.qualitynet.org](http://www.qualitynet.org)), and selecting *Portal Resources* in the upper right-hand corner. Under *Secure Portal User Guides and Training*, select:

- The *Non-QualityNet account holders* link to open the PDF for further instructions on registering for a *QualityNet* account.
- The *QualityNet account holders* link to open the PDF for further instructions in gaining Secure Portal access.

### **Other Notes**

- Your facility will not receive an FSR if:
  - Your facility was not open during the measure calculation period (January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017);
  - Your facility did not have any eligible cases during the measure calculation period; or
  - Your facility did not have a *QualityNet* Secure Portal user account with the appropriate designated roles.
