

St. Louis Region Profile

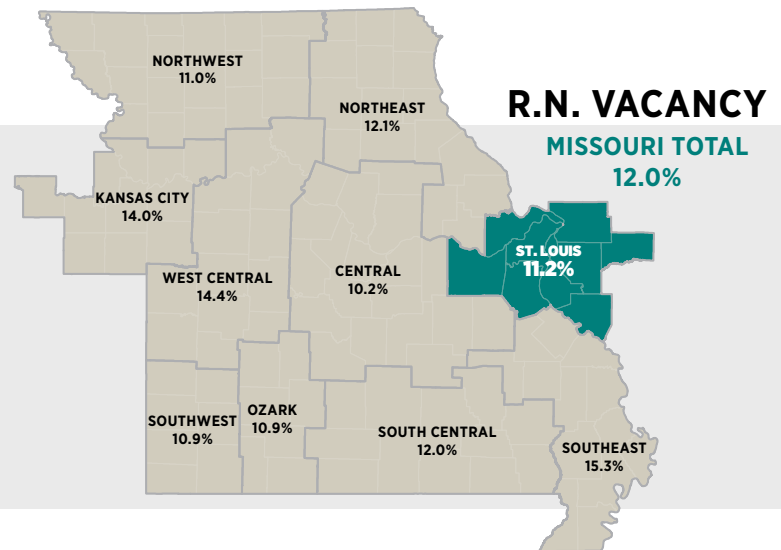
POPULATION: 2,025,851

This includes 29 Missouri hospitals and six Illinois hospitals.

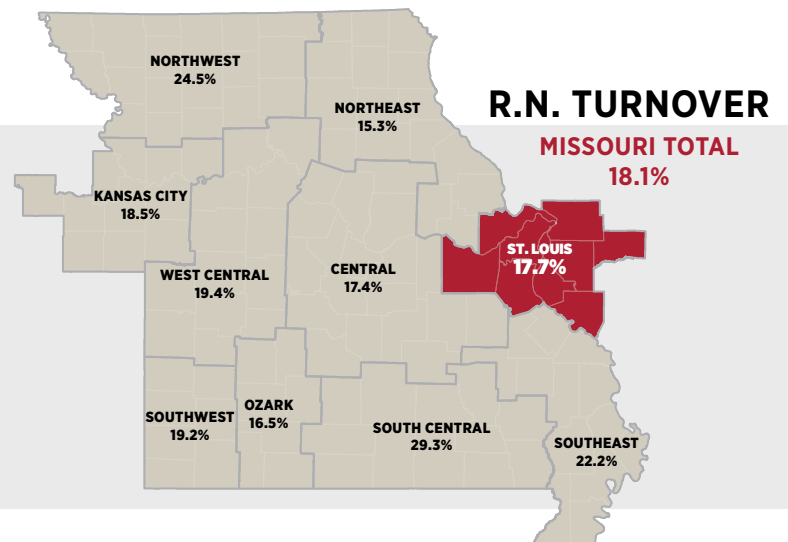
