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COVID-19: Updated mRNA Vaccines for Patients 6 Months & Older

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) are updating recent FDA changes for Covid-19 vaccines. The update is in a CMS MedLearn newsletter released late on September 14. The communication states that, "On September 11, the FDA approved and authorized for emergency use updated Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines formulated to more closely target currently circulating variants and provide better protection against serious consequences of COVID-19, including hospitalization and death. These vaccines have been updated to include a monovalent (single) component that corresponds to the Omicron variant XBB.1.5. The CDC recommends everyone 6 months and older get an updated COVID-19 vaccine."
